### Minutes from May 19, 2011, Meeting

1. Bill Lewis opened the meeting at 7:30 p.m.
2. Bill Lewis and Bob Davis handed out the Treasurer's report.
3. Bill Lewis and Tom Scally reported that we have priced the projector at ~\$600 and the camera at ~\$279. HD is sharper but the cost is much higher. Motion was made by Buz Buzzell and seconded by Tom Scally to go forward. It was unanimously approved Sony.
4. Doug Hutzell recommended that we make a cash contribution to Mt. Aetna.
5. Lee Gillespie reported on Boonsboro & Clear Spring Days. Williamsport Days is in August. Lee will continue to explore.
6. Doug Hutzell said that October 8<sup>th</sup> is Project Healing Waters on Beaver Creek.

10. Doug Alexander gave his presentation on Bamboo. He said that there were hundreds of species of bamboo, with Tonkin being the best for fly rods. He said that bamboo has a softer action but is stronger than high modulus graphite. He described construction techniques, including splitting bamboo, tool use, and glues. He highlighted that tubular split bamboo is the latest split bamboo, which makes a lighter rod.
